# OI. 'ARCHIMEDE' CABINET

With its fluted, curved doors and polished finish, this slender column would not look out of place in a cocktail bar. Yet the wall-mounted cabinet was designed primarily for use in the bathroom: its stainless steel base swivels to let you store toiletries on its glass shelves, while the lacquered surfaces are available in a choice of opaque colours, including Champagne and Siena. ### 02. 'DUO' CABINET by Roberto Lazzeroni.

Available in either a tall or low version, this elegant bar cabinet is part of Roberto Lazzeroni's extensive 'Duo' furniture collection. It features a wonderful mix of carefully chosen materials, including solid ash wood for the frame, a choice of natural walnut or ebony finish and a maple interior for the storage unit, shaded bronze for the metal handles, and marble, back-painted glass or ash veneer for the top. Milan-based designer Filippo Carandini is known for his bold furniture featuring vibrant colour blocks and tactile materials. Among his latest creations is a series of cabinets 'designed to interact and merge with its surroundings through reflections and space fragmentation'. All pieces feature hand-painted chequerboard fronts, metal details and bright red interiors. # 04. 'OTO' CONSOLE

by Studio OE, for Mattiazzi

A Berlin-based outfit founded by Anne-Sophie Oberkrome and Lisa Ertel, Studio OE was tasked by Mattiazzi creative director Konstantin Grcic to design 'furniture that can be used in the periphery of chairs'. The result, titled 'Oto', comprises a bench, side table and two consoles in okoumé wood, which can also be used as room dividers or seating. 'It's like a mobile extension of architecture,' explain the young designers. 'Like a railing, they nestle along furniture and walls and complement them with additional shelving and seating space.' €728, mattiazzi.eu

## 05. 'OLLIE' SHELVING

Leading global studio Yabu Pushelberg has famously designed stunning interiors for the likes of W Hotels and Aman Resorts. On a smaller scale, but still as impactful, is its series of translucid pieces for glass furniture specialist Glas Italia. The latest in the collection is a totem-like freestanding bookcase with graphic shelves, in 10mmthin extra-clear crystal glass, supported by a double-sided mirror panel, which creates a game of reflections and conveys an illusion of depth and continuity.
